The SPOT ADMISSION ROUND consists of the vacant seats available at Cluster Innovation Centre in two undergraduate courses (B.Tech (IT&MI) and B.A. Honours (Humanities and Social Sciences)), if any, for the candidates who appeared for the entrance examination and fall within the selection range. No fresh registration is allowed.

The following candidates are eligible for SPOT Round:

- a) Candidates who have appeared in the B.Tech (IT&MI) and B.A. Honours (Humanities and Social Sciences) entrance examination 2018 fulfilling the minimum eligibility conditions as per the UG bulletin, 2018.
- b) In addition, candidates who were allotted seat in admission lists 1 to 5 but could not take admission.

The following candidates are NOT eligible for SPOT Round:

- a) Candidates who withdrew/cancelled admission after taking admission in B.Tech (IT&MI) and B.A. Honours (Humanities and Social Sciences), for whatsoever reason, will not be considered for spot admission round.

Procedure of spot admission:

The candidates have to follow the following steps in order to participate in SPOT round for admission:

1. The candidate must appear in person at the Cluster Innovation Centre according to the spot-admission schedule as announced on the Admission Portal. If a candidate fails to present himself/herself on the specified round at the date and time assigned in the Spot admission schedule, he/she forfeits him/her candidature and will not be considered. Therefore, candidates are advised to personally attend the spot admission at the designated date and time.
2. Candidate must bring the relevant certificates/documents which need to be produced at the time of admission failing which seat in spot round will not be offered.

3. Once the committee approves the admission of the candidate online, a fee link will be activated in the candidate's portal. The candidate must pay the fee online within the stipulated time, failing which his/her admission will stand automatically cancelled.

Important Instructions

- Number of candidates called for Spot admission is higher than the actual number of seats available in all categories. However, a waiting list will be prepared from the candidates present for the spot admission.
- If the seats remain vacant after expiry of payment deadlines, the same will be offered to the candidates in the waiting list. Keep checking website for the list of candidates who may be offered seats further (if required).

Fee Payment deadline: Fees to be paid before 12.00 noon on 14th August 2018.

Those candidates who are in waiting list have to report at CIC at 1.30 p.m. on 14th August 2018. Admission may be given at this stage only seat(s) is/are vacant.
